

Week one: July 3th to July 7th from 9:00 am till 2:00 pm

Week two: July 10th to July 14th from 9:00 am till 2:00 pm

Week three: July 17th to July 21^{rst} from 9:00 am till 2:00 pm

The schedule will be as below:

From 9:00 am to 10:00 am sports skills every morning which will include different sports (soccer, basketball, dance, gymnastics, and volleyball)

From 10:00 am to 11:00am arts and crafts (students will make arts and crafts workshops) there will be a new activity each day.

From 11:00 am to 11:30 break and snacks. The students will have the time to eat and play on the playground. Students must bring their own snacks (nut free).

From 11:30 am to 12:00 pm French learning activity, while students will work on improving their French language skills.

From 12:00 pm to 2:00pm Team Building games which will include sports games (like capture the flag, jump and reach...) and board games (like risk, monopoly, katan, scrabble...).
