**Week three: July 17<sup>th</sup> to July 21<sup>st</sup> from 9:00 am till 2:00 pm**

The schedule will be as below:

**From 9:00 am to 10:00 am** sports skills every morning which will include different sports (soccer, basketball, dance, gymnastics, and volleyball)

**From 10:00 am to 11:00am** arts and crafts (students will make arts and crafts workshops) there will be a new activity each day.

**From 11:00 am to 11:30** break and snacks. The students will have the time to eat and play on the playground. Students must bring their own snacks (nut free).

**From 11:30 am to 12:00 pm** French learning activity, while students will work on improving their French language skills.

**From 12:00 pm to 2:00pm** Team Building games which will include sports games (like capture the flag, jump and reach..) and board games (like risk, monopoly, katan, scrabble...).
