We are looking forward to seeing you and our students on the first day of school Tuesday, September 6th from 8:45-noon. We are getting ready to welcome our returning families and a number of new families to our ESS community.

Over the summer, we bid farewell to our beloved Père Miguel who is in Spain now with his family and welcomed our new priest. Please join me in offering a warm ESS Bienvenue to our new school priest Père Gilbert who is also eager to meet our students and their families at our First school mass on Sept 9th, at 9 am. We also had to say goodbye for now to Mme Melki and Mme Auvinet. We wish them the best in their new adventures. We will introduce our staff and new educational assistants at our Meet the Teachers and PEC night on Sept 22nd at 5:30.

The theme of our new school year is "En quête de vérité, de guérison, et de réconciliation. Seeking Truth, Healing, and Reconciliation." Our theme visual for 2022-2023 could be explained this way: "The dove, a symbol of peace, represents the Holy Spirit. It can also remind us of the dove from Noah's ark that went seeking safety, refuge, and a place for a new beginning. The Holy Spirit reveals all truth. The cedar branch is a symbol of healing for Indigenous Peoples.

The circle represents God, who has no beginning and no end. The colours used can represent feelings and emotions: white is often considered a symbol of purity or joy, red, the colour we use at Pentecost and the Holy Spirit, symbolizes love, green for new life and growth, and pink, another colour for joy that is used (at Gaudete and Laetare Sunday) for the third candle of the Advent wreath.


